

## Christmas '23 with BOOKS for PEACE International Award - 7th Edition:


## Hymn to LIFE and Motherhood to UNFPA Albania



**Berlin, 21st of November 2023** - On **December** 17 at **Palazzo Cardinal Cesi**, that is the historic headquarters of the **General House** of the **Salvatorians** on Via della Conciliazione, bigwigs in Culture and Social Activities will be awarded the **BOOKS for PEACE 2023 International Prize**. This year's edition is dedicated to LIFE, Motherhood, the fight against Child Bride and against Infibulation.
