

Anna Caterina Stryjecka Ariano, a lifelong patron of the arts, dedicated herself to the promotion of culture and beauty, always alongside her now deceased husband, Paolo Ariano. Her roots run deep in Italy and Poland, two lands and cultures with an unbreakable bond. Her vision is the basis of this project, which celebrates the connection between peoples and traditions.

The project stems from a cross-cultural vision, with global scope, and is designed with a slant of visual anthropology, as an ethnographic collection of photographs, medical anthropology, thanks to music therapy, cultural diplomacy and soft power, aimed at strengthening dialogue between different cultures. The protagonists of this initiative are interdisciplinary and cross-disciplinary intelligences endowed with great curiosity, united by the passion for nature, travel, discovery, beauty and culture, universal values that transcend all borders.

A hymn to brotherhood, friendship and peace among peoples, celebrating the beauty of life and the unifying power of culture and infinite love for the mountains.

"I Volti dell'Africa" by Kazimierz Pichlak are portraits of a penetrating presence.

There are no studio shots, but fragments of life captured on camera, that represent the encounter between the traveling photographer and the people portrayed. The subjects of these photos are immersed in their own environment, while the photographer is far from his homeland and a guest in Africa.

The photographs on display at the exhibition are an attempt to capture the unique rhythm of that continent.

At the end of the event, **Anna Lord**, born in Finland to a Finnish refugee mother and an English professor and writer, author of the book "La Divina Artemisia", will offer to the guest an infusion of Artemisia, a plant that is considered sacred as well in Africa.

Kazimierz Pichlak is a surgeon by profession, but he also is a traveller, a poet and a photographer. He lives on the slopes of the Giant Mountains in Lower Silesia. He is a poet, with 12 published volumes and he received many awards.

He has had more than a dozen individual photographic exhibitions. He takes photographs to remember the emotion of discovering the beautiful and ugly fragments of the world. Basically, he is an occasional photographer.

He travels a lot and captures what he encounters along the way, from the first rays of sun on the giants of the Himalayas to the pensive face of an Ethiopian monk. Every now and then he finds himself in the right place at the right time and manages to take a noteworthy photo.

He is an honorary member of the National Association of Polish Surgeons, and has been named honorary citizen of his own large Polish region, Lower Silesia, for his merits in the fields of medicine, social work and culture.

He is the proud father of two children and grandfather of seven grandchildren.

He makes no secret of the fact that he considers himself a happy and fulfilled man.
